N8 FAMILY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

To apply for a N8 Family Financial Assistance Grant from The N8 Foundation, a parent or legal guardian of the diagnosed child must complete and submit the attached application together with all of the required supporting documents. Failure to fully complete all items and/or submit the required supporting documents may result in your application being delayed or denied.

What Is A Family Financial Assistance Grant?

A N8 Family Financial Assistance Grant is a monetary grant that the family of the diagnosed child can use for any purpose that benefits the physical or mental wellbeing of the diagnosed child, including, but not limited to, medical or non-medical expenses, family trips, treatment related travel expenses, etc.

Who Can Apply?

Any family with a child who has been diagnosed with DIPG and who resides in California. The applicant must be the parent and/or legal guardian of the diagnosed child.

What Documents Do I Need To Submit With The Application?

1. A photocopy of the diagnosed child's birth certificate;
2. Proof of residence in California; and,
3. A signed letter from the diagnosed child's treating physician (and/or assigned social worker) on the physician's and/or hospital's letterhead stating the child's full name, date of birth, diagnosis and date of diagnosis.
